Swimming Permission & Proficiency

Every Thursday during Summer Camp, we will be traveling by bus to the Bristol Hospital Wellness Center to swim at the Healthtrax Pool. To insure the safety of your child, we ask that you check the appropriate box designating whether your child is a

- non-swimmer (unable to swim on top of the water),
- novice swimmer (capable of swimming on top of the water but unable to tread water for one (1) minute), or
- proficient swimmer (capable of treading water for at least one (1) minute).

We will have a certified lifeguard on staff with us to supervise the pool area. Our child care staff will also be in bathing suits and supervising your children in the water as well as from the deck of the pool.

Camp staff **will not** remain at Imagine Nation Museum. All children in camp will travel to the pool. Staff will be assigned to supervise non-swimmers that do not enter the pool and engage them in appropriate activities on the pool deck.

If your child(ren) will be in the water, please supply a bathing suit and towel.

Please fill out and sign the below portion. Detach the bottom half and return it to the museum on or before your child's first day of Camp. A **separate slip must be completed for each child attending camp.**
